Okeanos Aquascaping offers gorgeous marine and freshwater aquascapes that blend expertly into any interior to create an eye-catching conversation piece without dominating or distracting.

Martin Schapira has been planning fresh and saltwater aquaria since age ten, and has turned a lifelong passion into a profitable enterprise. His company Okeanos, named after the 'world ocean' believed by the ancient Romans and Greeks to encircle the earth, takes pride in getting its clients' aquaria as close as possible to nature. Traveling to Egypt and the Caribbean to research marine and freshwater ecosystems first-hand, Martin now designs aquascapes to accurately emulate their natural counterparts. ° We emulate caves found in reefs around the world using live rock, white sand and handpicked coral. The real trick to aquascaping is that it should not look like it was done by human hand - it should look like it all just fell into place as it is found in the wild."

Busy New York executives with little time for regular snorkeling trips to the Maldives can now, thanks to Okeanos, enjoy similar vistas in their Soho penthouses, with the added bonus of being able to modify and tweak this miniature ecosystem in accordance with their own personal taste. Similarly, Okeanos can add a centerpiece to hotel and serviced apartment lobbies on the lookout for an eye-catching feature to greet guests. From private bathrooms to restaurant dining halls, a well-designed aquascape is often all the feature you need. Martin Schapira attests that there's no chance of an aquascape getting boring - on the contrary, it is a chance to own "an ever-changing piece of living art. Every day there will be change, growth and movement."

While you certainly need space to establish a large aquarium, Okeanos offer a range of innovative options allowing your aquascape to naturally integrate with the existing dimensions and limitations of







space. Even reasonably small tanks require complex filtration, but Okeanos' aquascapers are resourceful in finding places to conceal the messier side of their elegant creations without impacting their effectiveness - garages, dressers and wall units can all be adapted to house the mass of pipes and filters. For example, in a modestly-sized paneled lounge, the problem of where to put the flatscreen television after the installation of a large marine tank in front of the sofa was elegantly solved by having the television able to roll up in front of the aquarium at the touch of a button. Nothing good on? Tap the remote and you can instantly switch over to live aquatic entertainment.

Okeanos' customization to client specification means there's little margin for error, especially when clients can expect to invest anything from \$15,000 to the low millions in a new aquarium. Often designs are ripped up in the pre-planning stage because the designers aren't happy with the way things are going. A recent New Jersey project featured \$75,000 worth of hand-picked corals and marine life - with that kind of outlay for something finely balanced as a marine ecosystem, it is simply inexcusable to allow designer errors to slip through the net, meaning Okeanos' master designers remain at the centre of decision making from paper to penthouse. As most of their high-profile clients are not aquascaping hobbyists, Okeanos also expertly maintain and service 90% of the aquaria they design to allay any client worries about upkeep.

While the bulk of their current clients remain in North America, Okeanos have recently expanded operations overseas, designing aquascapes in Israel and Italy. Martin Schapira himself confesses that "I always wanted to travel to China. I love the culture and can't wait to learn more about it." Committed to bringing his lifelong passion to new places, Martin and his partners at Okeanos are more than happy to travel overseas to personally oversee the installation and design of new aquascapes, sourcing first-rate local expertise to handle maintenance and servicing.
